The Ottawa Cursillo Movement is holding a Men's Weekend from February 1-4 at Centre de L'Amour in Plantagenet. The weekend is called a Cursillo. Cursillo is a Spanish word meaning "little" or "short" course. The Cursillo begins on Thursday evening with a short introduction and orientation and then the retreat phase begins. The weekend also includes a daily celebration of the Mass and times of prayer. A good part of each day is spent listening to talks given by a priest and Catholic lay men followed by group discussion. There are three meals provided each day. The weekend ends late Sunday afternoon. No one is too well informed or too spiritual to make a Cursillo. Cursillo could be for you. The Cursillo Movement is a powerful instrument of renewal in the Catholic Church. Its aim is to concentrate closely on the Person and teachings of Jesus Christ. The Cursillo gives those who attend it a living understanding of basic Christian truths and the desire to serve the Church.

Next Friday Feb 2nd is the Feast of Presentation of the Lord and the World Day for Consecrated Life. By tradition, we bless the candles that we'll be using for religious purposes in the coming year. Please feel free to bring any such candles to the 9:00 AM mass, when we will bless them.

On February 4th, after the 10 AM mass please join us down stairs with a home-made dish for four to share as a community in thanksgiving for Lillian and Edgar Martineau and Verna McConnell for the many years of dedication to the parish. The theme is a morning brunch.
